Optional School Supply List

Camden County Schools provides for the primary academic needs of each student. The following is a list of additional items that are often requested. This list serves "only" as a guide to make preparations for the new school year. It is best to confirm with the teacher during Open House if possible.

Pre-K	Crayons, markers, and #2 pencils
K	Crayons, markers, #2 pencils, glue sticks, blunt end scissors, 1 Black/White Composition Book, 1 one inch binder, 1 three inch white binder with sleeve, and pencil pouch/box
1	Crayons, markers, #2 pencils, glue sticks, headphones/earbuds, blunt end scissors, 1-2 Black/White Composition Books, 1 one inch binder, 2 vinyl 2-pocket folders, 1 one subject spiral notebook, 2 pink large erasers, and pencil pouch/box
2	Crayons, markers, #2 pencils, glue sticks, colored pencils, cap erasers, 3 pocket folders with prongs, 1 1/2 inch binder, student scissors, headphones/earbuds, pencil box, liquid glue, 2 Black/White Composition Books, 1 one subject spiral notebook, and dry eraser markers
3	Crayons, markers, #2 pencils, 5 glue sticks, colored pencils, pencil pouch/box, cap erasers, 6 pocket folders with prongs, 1 1/2 inch binder, student scissors, wide ruled notebook paper, headphones/earbuds, liquid glue, 2 Black/White Composition Books, 1 one subject spiral notebook, and dry eraser markers
4	Crayons, markers, pack of #2 pencils, 5 glue sticks, colored pencils, pencil pouch/box, pack of cap erasers, 6 pocket folders with prongs, 1 1/2 inch binder, student scissors, wide ruled notebook paper, headphones/earbuds, liquid glue, 4 Black/White Composition Books, 4 one subject spiral notebooks, and highlighters
5	Crayons, markers, pack of #2 pencils, 5 glue sticks, colored pencils, pencil pouch/box, pack of cap erasers, 6 pocket folders without prongs, 2 vinyl 2-pocket folders with prongs, 1 1/2 inch binder, student scissors, wide ruled notebook paper, headphones/earbuds, liquid glue, 4 Black/White Composition Books, 4 one subject spiral notebooks, and highlighters
6-8	# 2 pencils, notebook paper, blue or black ball point pens, basic calculator, composition book, and 6 pocket folders with 3-hole prongs or 3-ring binder with dividers (See teachers about which of the last 3 items the student will need.)

9-12	# 2 pencils, notebook paper, 4 pocket folders with 3-hole prongs or 3-ring binder with dividers, blue or black ball point pens, and Casio fx-115ES scientific calculator
