

Non-System Approved Materials

Non-system approved instructional materials and other media materials may not be used in classrooms without being reviewed and approved by the appropriate committee. Non-system approved materials include, but are not limited to, instructional materials such as books, periodicals, videos, and computer software. Each school media committee or instructional committee is responsible for developing procedures for reviewing and approving non-system approved materials based upon state and local policies.

Any non-system owned video media must be donated to the school prior to review and approval.

No privately owned or copied computer software may be loaded onto school system computer hardware without prior approval, as described in these administrative procedures.
